Script Minute gothic textura, almost of rotunda in type, with simplified curved letters such as *b* and *p*; slightly enlarged letters at the beginning of sentences and punctus on line marks main pause. Even in such a small script, the letters are clear and well-formed.

Abbreviations Standard and fairly abundant, but none of an elaborate kind

Decoration Capitals have red strokes to distinguish them, with remnants of blue and red ornament, col.1, line 20
