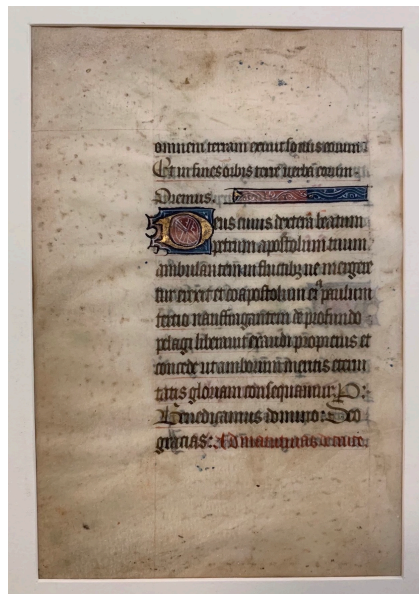
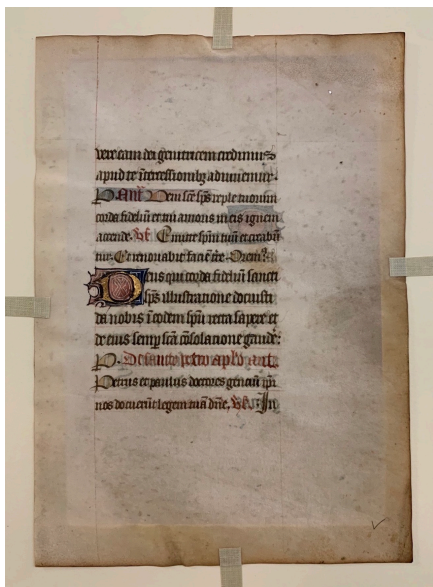


Contents: The text opens in the memoria of the Holy Spirit, followed by the psalm antiphon *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* [Come, Holy Spirit] and suffrage to Saint Peter. The text breaks at the rubric for matins of the Cross.

The transcription follows the layout of the single column of 13 lines, with hyphens added for words broken at the end of lines. Expanded scribal abbreviations are underlined, decorated versals are indicated in bold and rubrics in red.
